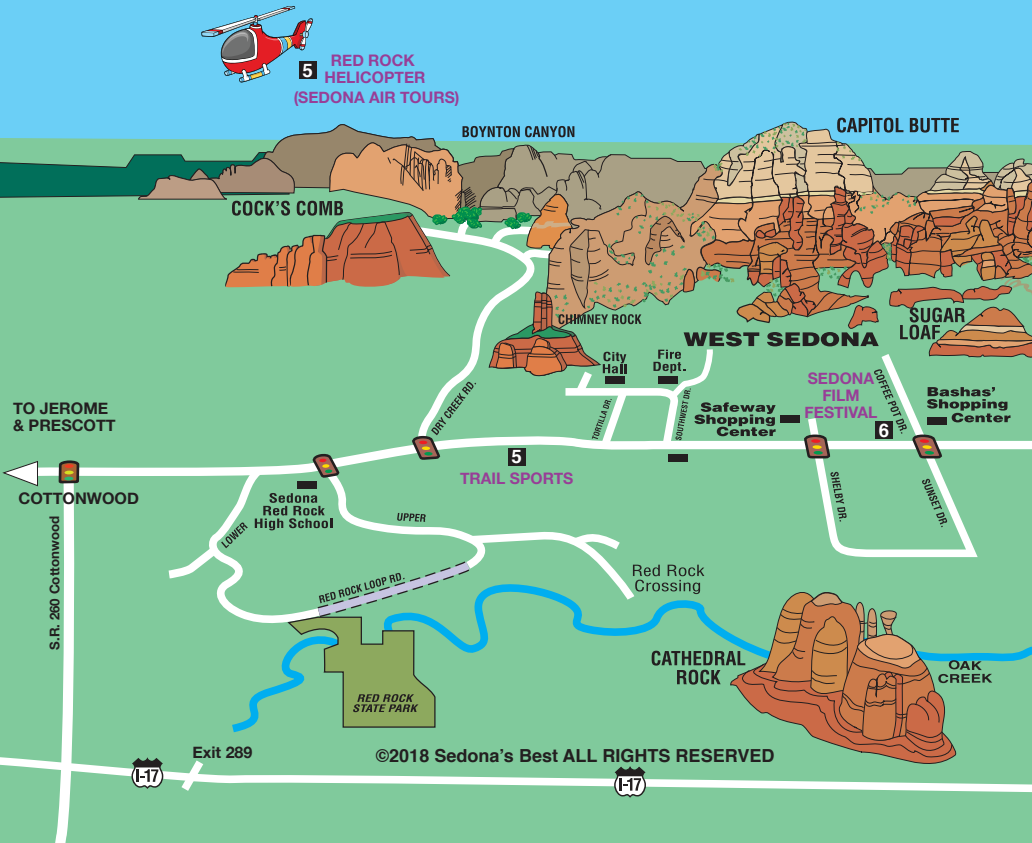

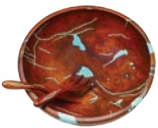

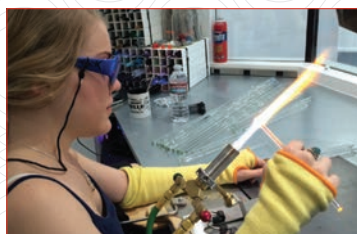
Just as rare as Sedona's Beauty is the unusual diversity of plant and wildlife in this area. Due to a tremendous change in altitude of 2,000 feet, there are about eight plant communities from the top rim to the mouth of the canyon.

These form various "ecozones" that house over 355 species and over 55 types of mammals. In the remote areas, you may encounter black bears, mountain lions and bobcats. It's not unusual to see a coyote or a herd of javelina parade across the street! With 80 types of fish, amphibians and reptiles, you might meet up with harmless lizards known to scoot across the sidewalks in search of

shade. The Sedona area boasts over 550 species of seed plants like the colorful prickly pear cactus, which bears a scrumptious fruit that becomes jellies, sauces and cocktail mixes. The century plant sprouts a 12-foot asparagus looking stem in just 7 days at the end of 25 years! The ancient Indians roasted this plant in pits like we do artichokes and used the other leaves to make needles, thread, baskets, shoes, eating utensils, and more! Appearing at first glance to be barren, the desert is actually bursting with beauty, with plants offering hundreds of uses from shampoos to food for man's survival and comfort.

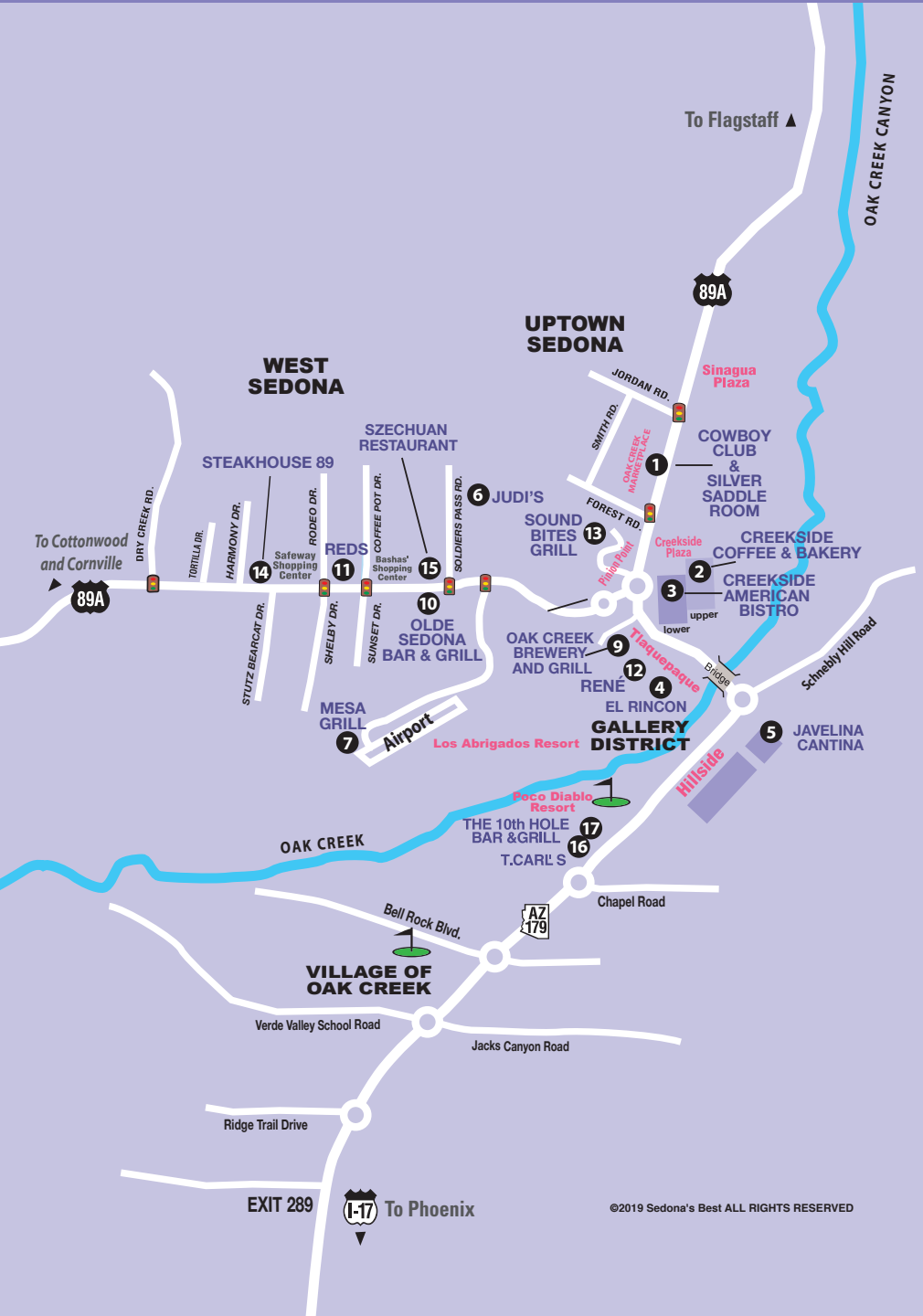

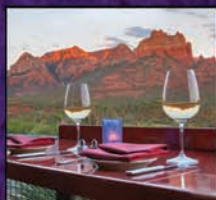

- Crescent Moon Ranch - admission fee.
Beautiful hike around Oak Creek leading to famous Cathedral Rock.

2 SCHNEBLY HILL VISTA

- 0.0 Go south on S.R. 179
- 0.3 Turn left at bridge to Schnebly Hill Road; continue over cattleguard. Road turns into a dirt road.
- 12.0 Parking area • Short hike to see vista
There's plenty of hikes along the way if you don't want to go to the top but it's well worth it.

3 WEST FORK (USFS #108)

- 0.0 Go north on S.R. 89A toward Flagstaff
- 10.3 miles
- 10.3 Parking area \$10 per car.
An unforgettable hike crossing over rocks in shallow creek the first three miles. Further up it requires hiking in water above your knees or deeper.

4 BOYNTON CANYON (USFS #47)

- 0.0 Go west
- 3.1 Miles turn right on to Dry Creek Road; stay till it ends
- 5.9 Turn left on to Boynton Pass Road
- 7.4 Turn right onto Boynton Canyon Rd. Go to 7.6 parking area.
Hike 1.5 miles to cliffside ruin.

SEDONA HISTORY

In a far away place in time, ancient winds began to blow rose-colored sand grains into magnificent mesas of crimson. These pinnacles have been sculpted by wind and water into monuments of timeless beauty called Sedona. The Hohokam had moved into the area by 700 A.D. Next, the Sinaguan means "without water," or farmers who rely on rainfall alone) arrived in the Sedona area. They were forced to leave after a violent volcanic eruption in 1066 A.D., which created the Sunset Crater. The residual volcanic ash, however, made the soils very fertile. This attracted the highly civilized Anasazi or "Ancient Ones" to join the returning Sinaguans. The Anasazi taught them to build sophisticated multi-storied pueblos, whose remains still stand today. Crude etchings in the rocks near ancient Indian ruins mark the beginning of Sedona's Art History. Their petroglyphs (etchings) and pictographs (paintings) are relished today as timeless art forms. They can still be viewed in the many Indian ruins that dot the Sedona area.

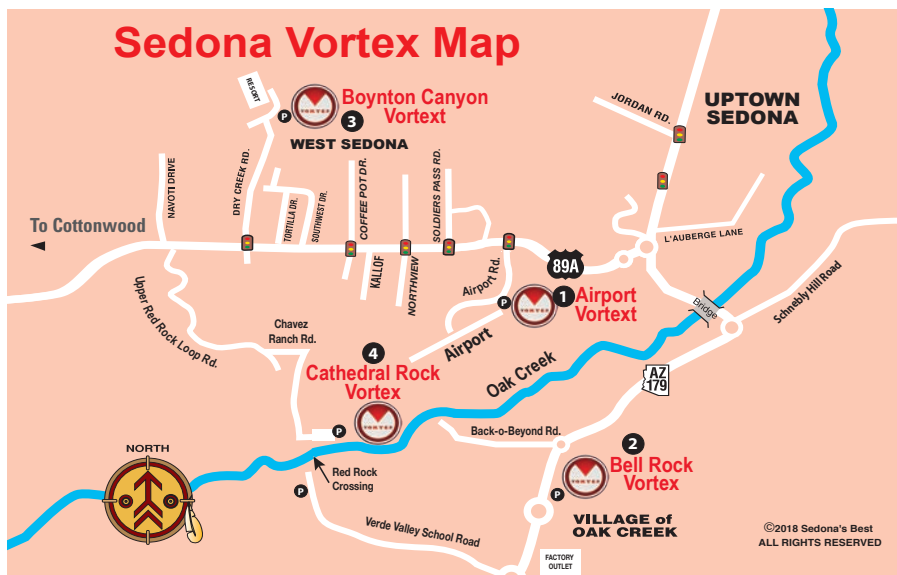
In the late 1300's, an unexplained occurrence caused these people to leave, almost overnight. Remnants of their corn cobs show they were still roasting in their fires! In 1583, it is believed that Antonio de Espejo was the first white man to travel to Red Rock Country. Pioneers, prospectors and trappers began to arrive in the early 1800s. In 1876 John "Jim" Thompson built his cabin in Oak Creek Canyon and became the first permanent white settler. An escaped convict from California,

named C.J. "Bear" Howard, built his hideout cabin at West Fork of Oak Creek. Bear Howard's cabin ironically became the Mayhew Lodge, where years later it was expanded and became a secret refuge of elite movie stars and presidents from around the world!

In 1901 a Pennsylvania Dutch couple, Theodore and Sedona Schnebly, moved to the area and purchased 80 acres. Hoping to get a post office established here, Theodore submitted the name "Schnebly Station." It was rejected because it was too long. His brother, Ellsworth, suggested using his wife's name. In 1902 the town was officially named "Sedona". Author and producer, Zane Grey wrote his famous book "Call of the Canyon". In 1923 Zane Grey convinced producer, Jesse Lasky to film the silent hit movie based on that book in its actual setting. After its success, film crews flocked to Sedona's beautiful Red Rock Country. Since then hundreds of movies have been filmed here. Today, the International Sedona Film Festival has become a world-class venue.

Another major landmark in Sedona's art history was the founding of the Cowboy Artists of America. Joe Beeler, Charlie Dye, John Hampton and Robert MacLeod founded this group on June 23, 1965 at the present day Cowboy Club Restaurant. Its purpose is to authentically perpetuate the memory and culture of the Old West. SEDONA'S TOP FOUR VORTEX HIKING TRAILS

1. AIRPORT VISTA VORTEX

UPFLOW • ELECTRIC • MASCULINE

Directions: From the "Y" take 89A west 1.0 miles to Airport Road on the left. Turn left and go 0.5 miles and park in the turnout on the left. If you're looking to supercharge your prayers or mantras, perhaps the Airport Vista Vortex will take you there. This vortex supposedly will enhance your clarity and perspective on your life.

2. BELL ROCK PATHWAY

UPFLOW • ELECTRIC • MASCULINE

DIRECTIONS: To get to Bell Rock Vortex from the "Y" head south on State Rte 179. Take 179 for about 5 miles to the to the Scenic View Sign which is North Bell Rock Parking lot. The Bell Rock Pathway is a 3.6 mile trail. Along this pathway you'll enjoy fantastic views of Bell Rock, Courthouse Butte and other landmarks. Best known as a meditation site for inducing problem solving from an ethereal perspective, Bell Rock Vortex offers more than an opportunity to contemplate and reflect. The energy here is invigorating and assists in spiraling your prayers and goals to the universe.

3. BOYNTON CANYON TRAIL

INFLOW • MAGNETIC • FEMININE

Directions: From the "Y" go west 3.1 Miles turn

right on to Dry Creek Road until it ends. Go 5.9 miles and turn left onto Boynton Pass Road go 7.4 miles. Turn right onto Boynton Canyon Rd. Go 7.6 miles to the parking area.

The Boynton Canyon Vortex is near the entrance of the trail. Follow the Boynton Vista side trail for approximately a half a mile to the vortex located at the base of a rock spire, which is known as Kachina Woman. A feeling of getting more down to earth and coming home is elicited from the calming Boynton Canyon Vortex.

4. CATHEDRAL ROCK VORTEX

INFLOW • MAGNETIC • FEMININE

Directions: From the "Y" Go west towards Cottonwood. Go 4.2 miles. Turn left (south) to Red Rock Loop Road or US Forest Road #216. Go 6.2 miles. Turn left at fork in the road to go to Red Rock Crossing/Crescent Moon Ranch

Cathedral Rock is the most iconic formation of them all! It is not only the center of the vortexes but Cathedral Rock is also the most photographed, symbolizing Sedona's beauty and spirituality. This vortex is said to conjure up reflections of your past and its healing energy will refresh your perspectives and embellish your problem solving skills. This is considered the heart of Sedona.

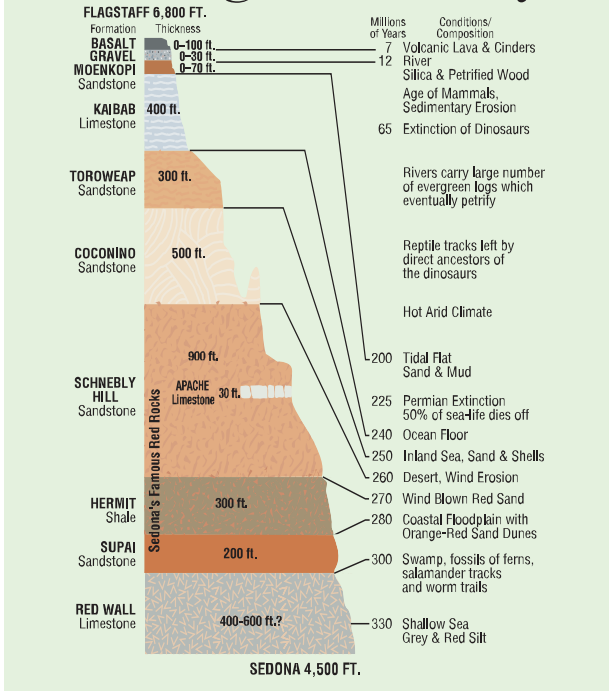

Geological History



SEDONA'S RED ROCKS

Sedona's famous formations have been slowly created for over 350 million years of time. From oceans to deserts to volcanic eruptions, Sedona's geological events have been quite active, all contributing to the fascinating vistas we see today.

To understand the geological history of the area, imagine the surface of the land to be a gigantic layer cake about 5,000 feet (above sea level) high and about 150,000 square miles in area called the "Colorado Plateau". If we were to cut a slice of this cake, we would see about ten various layers of sedimentary rock signifying different geological events.

As you may notice in the diagram pictured here, the three formations, Schnebly Hill,

Hermit and Supai— compose the distinctive, beautiful formations of Sedona. This is due to their unusual susceptibility to erosion. The Supai Formation was named after the Havasupai Indians and is the softer, pale-pink to reddish-brown sandstone. Sedona's exceptional scarlet color comes from the red iron-oxide stains formed when flood plain deposits of iron minerals mixed with available oxygen at that time. Faulting helped the creek waters to break through the lava cap and carve the magnificent canyons. The forces of nature that have contributed to Sedona's colorful canyons and sandstone monoliths are many and today offer a powerful, panorama for all to behold!

ABOUT SEDONA

Did you know?



The sun shines an average of over 300 days of the year in Sedona, Arizona. That's more sunshine than Florida!

Arizona has more National Parks and National Monuments than any other state and SEDONA is centrally located by most of them!

Sedona and Arizona have more mountainous countryside than Switzerland.

Sedona is located in the southern part of the largest stand of Ponderosa pines in the world!

NATIONAL & STATE PARKS

1. DEAD HORSE STATE PARK

Cottonwood. Located along the Verde River with 330 acres of picnicking, campsites and a fishing pond. A bird watcher's paradise in late spring. Hwy 89A Cottonwood.

2. FORTVERDE HISTORIC PARK

Camp Verde. Located in the town of Camp Verde, this fort was built in 1871 mainly as a supply and operations base. Interesting museum of the time period. I-17 Camp Verde Exit.

3. JEROME STATE HISTORIC PARK

Jerome. An old ghost town, this park recreates the old copper mining town's picturesque past. Hwy 89A Southwest.

4. RED ROCK STATE PARK

Sedona. Over 286 acres of beauty are preserved for you to discover the nature of Sedona. Lectures, exhibits, videos and guided tours inform you on flora, fauna, wildlife, geology and history. Lower Red Rock Loop Road off Hwy 89A South, Sedona.

5. SLIDEROCK STATE PARK

Oak Creek Canyon. Mother Nature's natural slick waterchute in Oak Creek offers a thrilling way to cool off. Picnicking is allowed but pets and glass containers are not. About 5 miles North of Sedona on Hwy 89A.

6. GRAND CANYON NATIONAL PARK

The world's most spectacular wonder of geological events! The Grand Canyon is 227 miles long and 4–18 miles wide and about one mile deep. You can visit the South Rim, which is only two hours from Sedona. Hwy 89A North through Oak Creek Canyon to I-40 West in Flagstaff.

7. MONTEZUMA CASTLE NATIONAL MONUMENT

Camp Verde. A misnomer, this well-preserved ruin was named after the emperor but he never came this far. Built by the Si-

nagua people ("without water") between 1100–1400 A.D. this pueblo cliff dwelling is an excellent reminder of their superior level of civilization. I-17 South Exit 289.

8. MONTEZUMA WELL NATIONAL MONUMENT

Rimrock. Actually a natural sinkhole, the remains of this ancient cavern were created by water percolating through limestone. It provides about 1.5 million gallons of water each day. Ancient people considered it a sacred place. I-17 South Exit 293.

9. SUNSET CRATER NATIONAL MONUMENT

A beautiful 400-foot crater formed by a volcanic eruption in 1066 A.D. Ice is a year-round phenomenon in the Ice Caves nearby. Astronauts trained for lunar missions here because of the moon-like landscape. From Flagstaff, 12 miles North of the Flagstaff Mall on 89A, then 2 miles East on signposted road.

10. TUZIGOOT NATIONAL MONUMENT

Clarkdale. An Apache word for "crooked waters," this Indian ruin was probably named after the meandering Verde River. Built around 1000–1400 A.D. by the Sinaguans. Hwy. 89A South Clarkdale.

11. WALNUT CANYON NATIONAL MONUMENT

You can use your imagination and pretend to live the life of a Sinaguan as you descend the 3/4-mile winding trail past 25 cliff dwellings. Or choose the easier Rim Trail. From Flagstaff, 7 miles East on I-40 To Walnut Canyon Exit 204. Three miles South on a paved road.

12. WUPATKI NATIONAL MONUMENT

An estimated 2,000 archaeological sites are said to be found on this ruin. Wupatki Ruin offers a self-guided trail which includes a trip by an ancient ball court. (From Flagstaff Visitor Center it is 14 miles East of 89A.)

There are six campgrounds operated by the Forest Service totaling 173 sites. They are open on a "first-come, first-serve" basis from Memorial Day through Labor Day. However, Chavez Crossing is open year round and 11 sites at Cave Springs Campground are available for reservation; phone 877.444.6777. Private campgrounds, RV facilities and over 200 RV sites are available in Sedona. Call the Sedona Ranger Station 282-4119 or the Sedona Chamber of Commerce 282-7722 for more information. 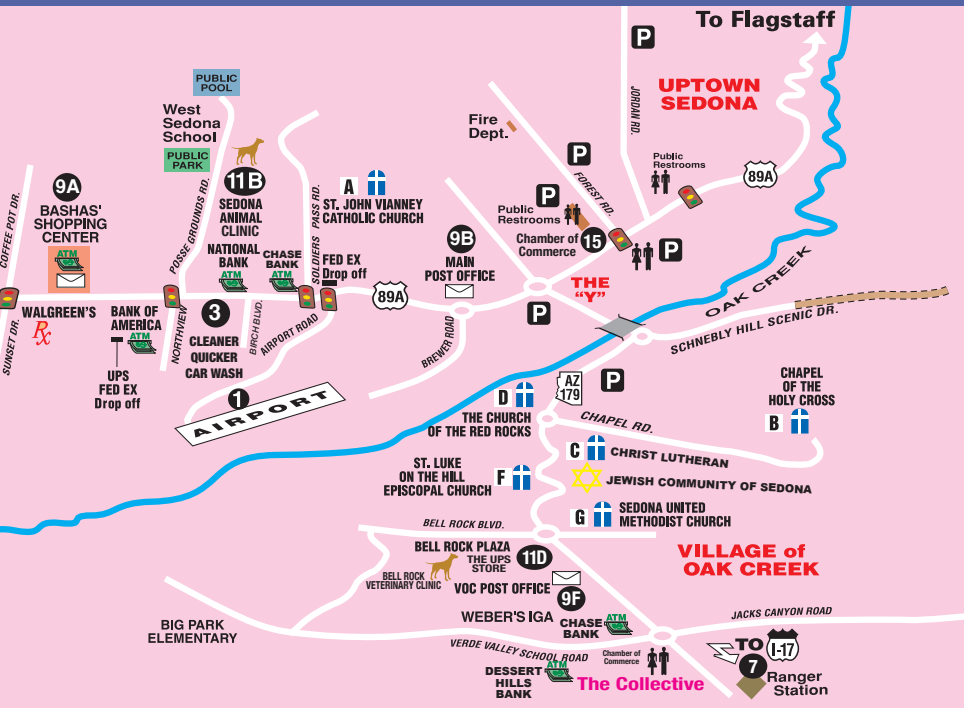

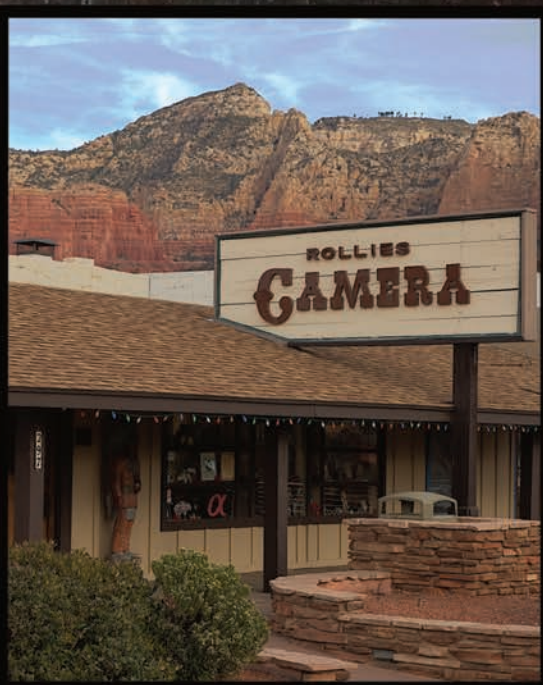
